

  - If a session awards contact hours, it will appear on the left-hand side of the screen in the ENA Events app.







#### Task One - Contact Hour Claim


1. Click 'Contact Hour Claim' to begin this task.

- 3. Click 'Unlock Evaluation' to open the Session Evaluation.




- 4. Attest you have attended the chosen session.

- 6. Click 'Submit' to save each Session Evaluation. You will return to the Contact Hour Claim page.




NOTE: You must complete a Session Evaluation for each session you wish to claim contact hours.

1. Click 'Overall Evaluation' to begin this task.





1. Click 'Download Certificate' to begin this task.






### <u>Task Four – Download Transcript</u>
