



Gail P. Lenehan Advocacy Award

Description

This award recognizes an emergency nurse who has had a positive impact on emergency nurses through a sustained commitment of advocacy for emergency nurses' well-being and welfare or the welfare of vulnerable populations.

Requirements

- Nominee must be an ENA member.
- Nominator must be an ENA member.
- Two narrative statements (addressing three separate criteria listed below) written by two different individuals. One narrative must be written by the Nominator.
- CV / Resume summary of the Nominee (please see page 2 in the Achievement Awards Handbook for a list of specific information needed).

Narrative Statements / Criteria

Please do not include the name of the nominee in the narrative statements.

- Each response must be limited to a maximum of 200 words.
- Develop responses in a word processing program such as Microsoft Word, use the WORD COUNT checker to ensure your responses are limited to 200 words, as well as the spell-check option. Then copy and paste responses into the online nomination form.

Narrative statements should address each criterion listed below:

1. Provide specific example(s) of the extent and significance of the nominee's involvement and collaboration in documented advocacy activities/efforts, outside of paid work time, related to emergency nursing or vulnerable populations.
2. Provide specific example(s) of outcomes or impact that resulted from these activities.
3. Provide specific example(s) of the enduring nature of the nominee's activities.
