

Judith C. Kelleher Award for Contributions to Emergency Nursing

Description

This award, named after one of ENA's co-founders, honors a member of ENA who has consistently demonstrated excellence in emergency nursing and has made significant contributions to the profession and to ENA. The award is presented at the Anita Dorr luncheon during ENA's Emergency Nursing Conference.

Requirements

- Nominee must be an ENA member.
- Nominator must be an ENA member.
- Two narrative statements (each addressing three separate criteria listed below) written by two different individuals. One narrative must be written by the Nominator.
- CV / Resume of the Nominee must be uploaded at the end of the application (name and identifying
 information will be removed by ENA staff prior to review by the Awards Committee).

Narrative Statements / Criteria

Please do not include the name of the nominee in the narrative statements.

- Each response must be limited to a maximum of 200 words.
- Develop responses in a word processing program such as Microsoft Word, use the WORD COUNT checker to ensure your responses are limited to 200 words, as well as the spell-check option. Then copy and paste responses into the online nomination form.

Narrative statements should address each criterion listed below:

- 1. Provide specific example(s) of the outstanding knowledge and expertise in emergency nursing practice, advocacy, education or research demonstrated by the nominee.
- 2. Provide specific example(s) of how the nominee has been an exceptional role model for emergency nurses.
- 3. Provide specific example(s) of how the nominee educates, supports or advocates for diversity and inclusivity, evidence-based practice initiatives or a safe and healthy work environment.
